I have a suggestion for the post grant review (PGR) process. I understand the reasons for implementing PGR, and I agree with them. However, there are a number of people I have talked to that are opposed to PGR, as there are concerns about the high number of frivolous submissions that will be filed. In order to cut down on the number of frivolous submissions, I suggest a large fee for initially filing a request for PGR, wherein a percentage of the fee is returned to the requestor if the concerns raised in the PGR request have merit. I realize that giving back \$ is not at the top of the list, but I believe this practice could cut way down on the number of frivolous requests for PGR that are filed.
